

Subject: FSD PSA: Car Safety for FSD Dogs and Puppies

Hello, volunteers!

I hope this message finds you and the FSD pups you're raising or dogs you're fostering happy and healthy. The safety and wellbeing of our puppies and dogs is our top priority, and with the warm summer months approaching, we want to send a friendly reminder about FSD car safety policies.

When traveling with an FSD puppy or dog, please adhere to following guidelines:

- All passenger and backseat windows should be completely rolled up with the child lock on. **No** cracked windows. The driver's window can remain cracked or unrolled at your discretion.
- If you prefer to have the windows cracked or down during travel, the puppy or dog **must** be crated inside the vehicle.
- **No** puppies or dogs are allowed to sit or ride in the front passenger seat at any time.
- **No** puppies or dogs are allowed in the bed of a pickup truck at any time.
- Seatbelts, harnesses, or other pet tethers intended for vehicle use are an alternative option that may be acquired by the volunteer—they will not be provided by FSD. FSD approval is required before usage of any alternative vehicle restraint method.
- Puppies and dogs should **never** be left alone in a car under any circumstances.
